## MEMO TO PARENTS

We are very happy that your child will be a part of the 2019 camping season! We have many things to do which require your input such as transportation preference, T-shirt size, important health information about your child(ren), etc. To complete camp preparations, we need **your response by the following two deadlines: Note—the Health History & Medical Information form is part of this March packet—you have over 2 months to complete this form—it is not due until the 2<sup>nd</sup> deadline of June 1, but must be completed and turned in by June 1! (See Health History and Medical info below)**

### **I. Forms enclosed DUE on or before FINAL DEADLINE of APRIL 1, 2019:**

1. **Transportation form** – see #1 note below. First come, first served. Faxed/scanned copies are not accepted.
  2. **Camp wear order form** - see camp wear #2 note below.
  3. **Parental/Guardian Waiver, Release & Hold Harmless Agreement – NEW SIGNATURE REQUIREMENT** See #3 Waiver/Hold Harmless Agreement below.
  4. **Tuition Installment due - \$494 per child (statement enclosed).**
1. **Transportation Form due as soon as possible. Bus stop availability will be on first come first served basis with a final deadline of April 1<sup>st</sup>. Review this form carefully due to route & bus stop changes & bus availability.**
  - A. **ALL PARENTS** must return the transportation form **no later than April 1<sup>st</sup>** so Bus stops and Parent Carpools may be finalized and first preferences honored to the best of our ability. (Please note parent carpool rules on back of form).
  - B. We strongly encourage parents to use the bus transportation, including the Wyoming area, to minimize camp parking and driveway congestion. Parents preferring their own carpool must have their request turned in by April 1<sup>st</sup> so all other campers may be assigned to bus stops. You will receive **bus stop confirmation & group lists in the May mailing, as well as a form to specify authorized individuals who can drive your children.**
  - C. We are pleased to again use Queen City Transportation as they provided safe and reliable transportation for the past 4 summers. The bus fee of \$218 per child will be billed on your final statement in May.

**All Bus Transportation-** 6 bus stop locations: Amberley, Blue Ash, Hyde Park, Kenwood (back to Rockwern),  
\$218/six weeks Montgomery (new Ascension Lutheran plus Good Shepherd), Mason;  
plus Wyoming (street assigned pick up)

2. **Camp wear- All campers** will receive a **free camp T-shirt**; be sure to send in **your form by April 1<sup>st</sup>** for your child to **receive the correct size.** Additional shirts, shorts, sweatshirts, drawstring bag, personalized water bottle, and lunch bag may also be ordered by April 1<sup>st</sup> for the price indicated. **SPECIAL REQUEST:** We ask that campers' lunches be sent in either a regular paper lunch bag, the Wildbrook insulated lunch bag, or one of similar size (9"x7"x4") to fit in the refrigerators. Oversized coolers/bags will not fit.

3. **Parent/Guardian Waiver, Release and Hold Harmless Agreement - All parents/guardians are required to sign.** For each minor traveling to and from Wildbrook & on field trips as well as each minor's participation in all approved camp activities at Wildbrook. Families with multiple campers may complete 1 form.

### **II. Due June 1, 2019** (Forms **must** contain **original signature** and be mailed, **fax/scanned copies not accepted**)

1. Health History & Medical Information form for each child **enclosed in March mailing.** See Health History info below.
2. Camper Contract for Good Behavior- (will be included in May mailing.)
3. Field Trip Permission Slip- (will be included in May mailing, optional activity for campers).
4. Authorized Drivers List and parent phone #'s for Alert System (will be included in May mailing)
5. The final balance due (statement included in May mailing with tuition, transportation, camp wear & field trip fee.)

**Health History and Medical Information (due June 1)- 1.) Parent/Guardian must complete a health history for each child on the front of the medical form and sign Emergency authorization for treatment also on the front of the form. 2.)** We must have a **physician's signed exam** (back of form) within 24 months of the current camping season. (Physical exams completed after July 26, 2017). For returning campers, call the camp office if you are unsure of the date of your child's exam on file. Please do not delay, a fee will be charged for late forms! (Form included in March mailing).

**\*\*\*To attend to the safety and welfare of ALL CAMPERS:** We will strictly enforce our due date of June 1<sup>st</sup> for final payment and all forms, **including medical forms.** It is your responsibility to get forms in on time to ensure your child(ren)'s safety. **Those not received on time will result in a \$20 fee assessed per form per child.** We respectfully request your assistance and cooperation to ensure everyone's safety and welfare.
